This course is ideal for detectives handling property crimes, violent crimes, death investigations, and complex scenes where forensic interpretation can make the difference.

Course Objectives:

- Recognize, prioritize, and evaluate physical evidence at crime scenes
- Conduct more effective interviews by using crime scene observations to guide questioning
- Identify spatter and non-spatter bloodstain patterns and utilize that data during interviews
- Apply key principles of shooting incident reconstruction to investigative analysis
- Recognize indicators of staged crime scenes
- Differentiate key forensic considerations in death investigations, including homicide and suicide
- Translate forensic observations into clear, defensible investigative reports
- Strengthen courtroom testimony by clearly explaining forensic findings and investigative conclusions
