Happy retired in December of 2022 from the Anaheim Police Department after 28 years of service. During his tenure on the task force he has provided over 680 hours of HT training throughout the state of California and has presented on the subject of Human Trafficking, the Pimping and Pandering subculture and Prostitution to law enforcement personnel, NGO's, prosecutors, faith-based groups, students, victim advocates, medical professionals and to the general public. He has testified as an HT expert in Orange County Superior Court on numerous occasions and two of his cases have been cited and published by the State of California Fourth Appellate District – Division Three, People VS Clark- G055874 and People VS Calhoun- G055511. Happy remains passionate about providing advanced training and instruction to LEO personnel. This training will provide tried and proven investigative techniques and best practices for proactive operations as well as effective LEO responses which include preparing and submitting fileable cases for successful prosecution and conviction.
