Participants explore the Pathway to Violence, warning behaviors, Structured Professional Judgment tools, and protective intelligence investigations, and learn how these principles apply directly to dignitary protection operations. Through case studies, current research, and scenario-based exercises, students leave able to connect behavioral indicators and investigative intelligence to proactive protective strategies because prevention begins long before the first shot is fired.
