The Tactical Interviewing Method course is designed to instruct all types of law enforcement officers (Police, Corrections, Federal Agents, Parole, Probation, and others) from a variety of duty assignments (Narcotics, Robbery, Burglary, Gangs, Patrol, Investigations, Terrorism, etc....), to conduct effective prisoner interviews (debriefings) of new arrestees, jailed prisoners, prison inmates, probationers, parolees, and other individuals for the purpose of acquiring intelligence information and cultivating informants.
