Instructors

JENN BENJAMINS – Retired Sergeant, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Jenn has 22 years of law enforcement experience with expertise in undercover, supervising undercover and specialized units and training. Her interest in undercover work led her to the Vice Section, where she refused to be limited by traditional expectations. While excelling in female undercover roles, Jenn was determined - and succeeded - in working undercover alongside her male counterparts. Throughout her career, Jenn worked a wide variety of undercover assignments, collaborating not only with specialized units such as Narcotics, but also with federal partners including the ATF, DEA, and FBI. These experiences gave her a rare perspective on the skills, strategies, and challenges unique to undercover operations. Recognizing a critical need, Jenn has made it her mission to provide specialized training for women in undercover roles; programs that build technical expertise while also addressing the unique dynamics and challenges women face in the field.

Molly McGuire - Originally from Rochester, NY, Molly is a seasoned prosecutor with the Broward County State Attorney's Office, where she has built an impressive career since graduating from the New England School of Law in 2010. She has worked across multiple specialized units including Domestic Violence, Sexual Battery, Career Criminal, and the elite Homicide Trial Unit, where she was hand-selected in 2017 by State Attorney Michael Satz. Known for her integrity and sharp trial skills, McGuire has successfully prosecuted numerous high-profile cases, including death penalty and complex murder trials. She is widely respected as a subject matter expert in overdose death prosecutions, holding drug traffickers accountable through extensive case law knowledge and courtroom experience. In addition to her prosecutorial work, she is a dedicated instructor, providing advanced training in homicide investigations, cross-examination, interrogations, and search warrants. In 2025, she was honored as Prosecutor of the Year by the Florida Gang Investigators Association for her role in a major RICO case involving a violent criminal street gang. Outside the courtroom, she is a wife and mother of two.

Lili Infante - As a former DEA Special Agent, she pioneered the first federal task force focused on Dark Web and crypto investigations, leading landmark cases including the takedown of Hydra Market, the world's largest dark-web marketplace. Her work has earned national awards for cybercrime investigation and helped establish the investigative and policy frameworks now used by law-enforcement agencies worldwide. Lili is now the CEO and Founder of CAT Labs, a technology company helping government agencies find, seize and secure illicit cryptocurrency assets hidden in their seized evidence.
