INSTRUCTORS: Sgt **Lou Savelli**, NYPD, retired after 21 years with the NYPD as the detective supervisor of the Terrorist Interdiction Unit created on September 11th, 2001. He created NYPD's first citywide Gang Unit called the CAGE (Citywide Anti-Gang Enforcement) Unit which was awarded the Most Effective Gang Unit in the US. He has personally seized over one thousand guns and is considered the nation's leading expert on Armed Suspects. As a narcotics detective, Lou Savelli seized \$20 million in a single drug case which was the largest seizure of cash in World History at the time. He is the president of Homefront Protective Group Law Enforcement Training.

Sgt. **Eric Van Allen**, Kingston (NY) Police Dept. is one of the nation's leading experts on identifying and apprehending armed suspects and armed gang members. He is a 25-year veteran of Law Enforcement. He began his career as a communications officer followed by working as an undercover narcotics officer purchasing narcotics from street level dealers and gang members. During his time as a uniformed officer, he was assigned to a high crime urban area focusing on street level crimes, armed suspects, shootings, gang activity and narcotics offenses. He took part in NY's Operation Impact efforts by working in a plainclothes capacity interdicting armed suspects, street-level crimes and violence.
